Whistling Straits (Irish Course) — N8501 County LS

Whistling Straits Golf Course is located 15 minutes northeast of the Village of Kohler. A throwback to the raw freshness of Ireland sculpted into the Wisconsin coastline, Whistling Straits offers two courses which have hosted the PGA Championship and the Palmer Cup.

Just inland from the great lake and interspersed by four meandering streams, the grassland-and-dunes aspect of the Irish Course is a deceptively tranquil landscape. Both traditional and memorable, the Irish Course is full of unique challenges.

Directions: From The American Club, exit driveway left (north) onto Highland Dr. (also known as Cty Y.) Proceed 7.5 miles north to Cty FF. Turn right (east) onto Cty FF and proceed two miles to the Whistling Straits entrance.

From I-43 north or southbound, exit 128 east. Proceed east and take the first left - North 40th St. becomes Dairyland Dr. - four miles north to Cty FF. Turn right (east) onto Cty FF, proceed one mile to Whistling Straits entrance.
