

AFTER SCHOOL **Spanish**

The After-School Spanish Program offered by UW-Sheboygan Continuing Education is aimed at providing an opportunity for elementary students to gain exposure to the Spanish language at an early age.

Children in grades Kindergarten-5th will have fun learning about the basics including pronunciation, alphabet and number review, vocabulary building, common phrases and simple conversation.

The After-School Spanish Program will be offered this semester at various local elementary schools. Those students who have already completed a semester or more of Spanish are encouraged to enroll to reinforce and continue their study. Curriculum is rotated each year to accommodate both new and returning students. **Review work is extremely important for retention and each semester includes review work plus NEW Material.**

Class sizes are limited. Students will be grouped according to age in an effort to provide an optimum learning environment for all participants. Additional sections may be opened or teacher aides assigned based on total registrations and instructor availability. **No confirmation notices are sent due to time constraints. You may assume your child is enrolled in a class unless you are notified by our office otherwise.**

Please note that this program is administered by the UW-Sheboygan Continuing Education Office. The program is operated in cooperation with, but independently from local school systems and must consequently recover all associated costs. **No transportation is provided for this program.**

ABOUT THE **Instructors**

Instructors in the After-School Spanish Program bring a broad range of experiences to the classroom. Students will learn from instructors that have a solid background in Spanish and a strong desire to work with children as they discover how to communicate in a new language. Some of our instructors are university students who are studying Spanish and/or Education and have been recommended by university professors for participation in the program. Other instructors from the community bring a combination of classroom teaching experience, tutoring experience and foreign language skills. All of the instructors work together to create learning environments that are fun, creative and challenging.

The After-School Spanish Program was implemented in the Fall of 1997 by the UW-Sheboygan Continuing Education Office. The Office of Continuing Education is committed to providing academic enrichment programs for youth in Sheboygan County.

If your elementary school is canceled for any reason, Spanish classes will also be canceled. Cancelation notices will also appear on **Sheboygan Cable Channel 15**.
