Join us as we travel to the northwest of the country to explore and experience Seattle. UW-Sheboygan CE Director, Valerie Graczyk, and UW-Washington County CE Program Manager, Kim Schwamn, will escort you on this exciting five day, four night tour of the city on the banks of Puget Sound.

Upon our arrival we will take a four hour guided bus tour of the city, stopping in the downtown area to eat at any one of a variety of restaurants and then going to the Space Needle to view the city and surrounding area from its observation deck. On Friday you can spend the day at leisure around the city or take one of the

Saturday, we will take a walking food tour of the famous Pike's Place Market, and have the opportunity to sample some of the foods on sale, with the rest of the day to explore alone, using the two day double-decker tour ticket provided. On Sunday we will visit Tillicum Village on Blake Island to enjoy salmon cooked the traditional Northwestern Coast Indian style and experience the culture of this area.

The dates for the trip are Thursday, August 27–Monday, August 31, 2009. The cost of \*\$1,698.00 (if booked by February 28, 2009) or \$1,750.00 (if booked on or after March 1, 2009) is based on double occupancy. Included in the cost are transportation to and from Milwaukee and Seattle airports, return airfares, four nights accommodation at the Ramada Hotel in Seattle, two breakfasts, a two day Double Decker bus tour ticket, guided tours of the city and Pike's Place Market, the lunch trip to Tillicum Village and entrance to the Space Needle observation deck.
